Why did Airex energy raise \$38 million?

Airex Energy has raised \$38 million in a Series B funding round led by Cycle Capital to speed up the company's plans to expand its production of low-carbon products, biocoal and biochar, made from biomass.

Does Airex energy use biocoal?

Since 2016, the firm is running the first and only industrial production plant in Canada that specializes in biocoal. Currently, the primary material used by Airex Energy comes from sawmill residues or recycled wood shavings, but other sources are also possible. The company has conducted tests to work with compost that has no commercial value.
