AVANGRID's NECEC Project May Lawfully Proceed. ORANGE, Conn. -- April 20, 2023 -- The following are statements from Pedro Azagra, AVANGRID CEO and Scott Mahoney, Senior Vice President - General Counsel at AVANGRID regarding today's decision by a Cumberland County jury:

"The jury's unanimous verdict affirms the prior rulings of the Maine Supreme Judicial Court that the New England Clean Energy Connect (NECEC) project may lawfully proceed," Scott Mahoney, Avangrid's senior vice president and general counsel, said in a statement following Thursday's verdict.

The ruling, passed in a close 2-1 decision, empowers the FERC's direction for necessary upgrades, asserting that NextEra must adhere to the requirements set forth. This marks a crucial advancement for the NECEC project, which aims to deliver clean energy from Canada to Massachusetts.
