New Energy Partnership, an experienced team backed by significant equity investment are targeting delivery of more than 2GW of Battery Energy Storage Systems (BESS) and renewable energy projects this decade to support the country's transition to Net Zero.

This year saw a flurry of big financing deals announced by US BESS developers over the Spring and Summer. These included Canadian Solar subsidiary Recurrent Energy securing US\$513 million for a 1,200MWh project in Arizona in June and Intersect Power closing two financing deals worth a total US\$837 million for three projects in Texas a month later.

The competitive process will seek to select a private partner to finance, build and operate the photovoltaic (PV) park near the town of Midelt in the Atlas mountains, along with a 400-MWh battery energy storage system ...

The UK has been ranked the world's third most attractive country for BESS development, and major investment into the UK BESS sector has been on the rise. Power producer RWE has been making significant moves in the BESS sector, with the company recently announcing it was moving forward with proposals for a 350MW BESS to be located in Wales.

BESS developer-operator Aquila Clean Energy has started building a 50MW/100MWh project in Germany, its first major one in the country. The company announced the start of construction on the project in the Str&#252;bbel municipality in the state of Schleswig-Holstein earlier this week (26 August). It is the first of 14 projects planned in Germany ...

Developer-operator Masdar Arlington Energy has started construction on two BESS projects with a combined capacity of 55MW, one in Rochdale and one in Stockport. The announcement follows Masdar's ...

The Western Grid Development - BESS is a 5,000kW energy storage project located in Santa Paula, California, US. The electro-chemical battery energy storage project uses lithium-ion as its storage technology. The project was ...

The trio will become joint shareholders in three development-stage BESS projects totalling 395MW of capacity, comprising a 111MW project in Lombardia, a 97MW project in Puglia and a 187MW one in Piemonte. The ...

In January, TotalEnergies acquired German BESS developer Kyon Energy, for EUR90 million (US\$98 million) upfront, plus further payments linked to development targets, while a few months back in October, the French company switched on a 255MWh Saft BESS at a solar PV plant in Texas, US.

That announcement coincided with two large-scale BESS in Sweden being progressed by their owners. IPP Ilmatar now has a 50MW PV, 20MW BESS in Knihult fully permitted to start construction in 2024 while ...
