The Cocos (Keeling) Islands are a group of two coral atolls with 27 islands, located about halfway between Australia and Sri Lanka. Only two islands are inhabited, West Island and Home Island, with a combined land area of about 14 square kilometers (5.4 square miles).

There are only around 600 people living on the Cocos (Keeling) Islands in the Indian Ocean. But their beaches are littered with 414 million pieces of plastic. That's the calculation of a paper published in Scientific Reports. Its findings suggest the world has "drastically underestimated" the plastic pollution problem.
