The Christmas island strategic assessment on this page is on hold as at September 2023. This is as the Department of Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development, Communications, and the Arts (Infrastructure) has elected to pause the assessment while they explore their options.

Will development in Christmas Island National Park be part of the strategic assessment?

Development in the Christmas Island National Park won't be part of the strategic assessment. Activities in the National Park will still require individual approvals under national environment law. Interested stakeholders will have several opportunities to provide their feedback on these documents and throughout the strategic assessment process.

What is Christmas Island National Park's climate strategy?

While the Australian Government is committed to acting in accordance with the strategy, the attainment of objectives is subject to budgetary and other constraints affecting the parties involved.
