The two islands of São Tomé and Príncipe, along with a few associated rocky islets, are located in the Gulf of Guinea on the southern coast of West Africa. The main islands are a mix of flat and

mountainous areas of seemingly dormant volcanoes. São Tomé Peak is the highest point in the group, reaching a height of 2,024 metres (6,640 ft).

Abreu noted that "the panels and other equipment have arrived in the Port of Ana Chaves in São Tomé, following delays and uncertainties due to a shortage of maritime transport." According to World Bank data, 76.6% of the population of São Tomé and Príncipe have access to electricity, generated primarily through imported diesel (92%).

The two islands of Sao Tome and Principe hover just above the equator, 250km off the coast of Gabon. While other tropical paradises have been taken over by resorts, Sao Tome and Principe remain thankfully much as they were when the Portuguese first discovered them in 1470, save for the addition of the odd cocoa plantation and charmingly crumbling colonial town.

São Tomé and Príncipe (STP) is making significant strides in advancing its climate-development agenda. The country has taken an inclusive and whole-of-society approach to its mitigation and adaptation actions and is working to integrate climate change into core planning and budgeting processes at national and subnational levels.
