

Who chooses the Cabinet of the Dominican Republic?

The Cabinet of the Dominican Republic is chosen by the President of the Republic and can be removed by the president at any time. The cabinet ministers were known as Secretaries of State until 26 January 2010 with the proclamation of the new Constitution. Luis Abinader won the Presidency in the 5 July 2020 election.

The power sector in the Dominican Republic has traditionally been, and still is, a bottleneck to the country's economic growth.

Why is the electricity sector in the Dominican Republic in crisis?

As previously described, the precarious situation of the electricity sector in the Dominican Republic is not caused primarily by limited generation capacity. Although a reduction of losses may provide a more economic way of resolving the crisis, there are plans for significant new investments in new generation capacity, especially in hydropower.

How much electricity does the Dominican Republic use?

Electricity demand in the Dominican Republic has grown considerably since the early 1990s, at a yearly average of 10% between 1992 and 2003. Consumption is very close to the regional average, with annual per capita consumption of 1,349 kWh in 2003. Total electricity sold in 2005 was 3.72 TWh.

How many CDM projects are there in the Dominican Republic?

Currently (December 2007), there is just one registered CDM project in the electricity sector in the Dominican Republic, the El Guanillo wind farm, with estimated emission reductions of 123,916 tCO₂e per year. The World Bank is currently financing a Power Sector Technical Assistance Project.
