What is AMEA power doing in Egypt?

The first project, a new 1,000MW solar PV power plant with a 600MWh BESS in the Benban area, Aswan Governorate, will mark a historic milestone as the largest Solar PV and BESS project in Africa.

Did AMEA sign PPAs with Egyptian electricity transmission company?

AMEA power has signed PPAswith the Egyptian Electricity Transmission Company for both projects. The signing ceremony held on Thursday, September 12th, 2024, was attended by H.E. Dr. Mostafa Madbouly, Prime Minister of Egypt; H.E. Dr. Mahmoud Esmat, Minister of Electricity and Renewable Energy; and H.E. Mariam Al Kaabi, UAE Ambassador to Egypt.

How will the Kom Ombo plant benefit Egypt?

Nandita Parshad, Managing Director- Sustainable Finance Group, EBRD The Kom Ombo plant will contribute to the Egyptian government's target to generate 42 per cent of the country's electricity from renewable energy sources by 2035 while delivering one of the lowest generation tariffs in Africa.

Egypt is looking to make a dent in its plans to generate 42% of power from renewables by 2030, with the Egyptian Electricity Transmission Company (EETC) on 12 September signing 25-year power purchase agreements (PPAs) for 2GW of solar PV capacity split between two 1GW projects.

The Kom Ombo project is the first tendered utility-scale solar project in Egypt, and one of the first to be delivered under the Energy Pillar of the Nexus Water-Food-Energy (NWFE) initiative, whereby the Egyptian authorities are committed to developing 10 GW of new renewable energy projects and decommissioning 5 GW of thermal capacity.
