

Electrical enclosure St Vincent and Grenadines

Are the electrical outlets in Saint Vincent and the Grenadines the same?

Yes, the electrical outlets in Saint Vincent and the Grenadines are the same as in the United States, both countries use power plugs and electrical outlets of types A and B. However, the voltage and/or frequency used in Saint Vincent and the Grenadines is not the same as in the United States, so you may need a voltage converter.

What type of plug fits in a plug in Saint Vincent & the Grenadines?

No other plug types fit into an outlet of type G. All power sockets in Saint Vincent and the Grenadines provide a standard voltage of 230V with a standard frequency of 50Hz. You can use all your equipment in Saint Vincent and the Grenadines if the outlet voltage in your own country is between 220V-240V.

Can I connect my laptop charger to an electrical outlet in Saint Vincent & the Grenadines?

Yes, you can connect your laptop charger to an electrical outlet in Saint Vincent and the Grenadines as long as the outlet is compatible with the charger's voltage and plug type. In Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, the standard voltage is 230V and the standard frequency is 50Hz.

Do I need a travel adapter in Saint Vincent and the Grenadines?

The electrical outlets and power plugs in Saint Vincent and the Grenadines are of types A, B & G (see images). If your country uses the same electrical outlets and power plugs, you don't need a travel adapter. However, you may still need a voltage converter if the voltage is different.

What is the standard voltage in Saint Vincent and the Grenadines?

In Saint Vincent and the Grenadines the standard voltage is 110 / 230 V and the frequency is 50 / 60 Hz. Watch out! In Saint Vincent and the Grenadines more than one voltage is being used (110 / 230 V). It can depend on the region, the city or even the hotel which voltage you will come across.

What is the power supply in Saint Vincent and the Grenadines?

The power supply in Saint Vincent and the Grenadines is 110V, however some of the newer hotels operate at 230V. Electricity supplies worldwide can vary from anything between 100V and 240V. It can be extremely dangerous to use an electrical appliance that is rated at a voltage different from the supply.
