

Where is French Guiana located?

Specificities of the region: Located in South America, French Guiana is the second-largest region of France and the largest outermost region of the European Union (with a surface area of 83,846 km<sup>2</sup>). In terms of territorial organisation, French Guiana became a single territorial collectivity<sup>1</sup> in 2015.

What are the socio-economic challenges facing French Guiana?

The population continues to face systemic socio-economic challenges, particularly in terms of unemployment (13.1% in 2022), exposure to poverty (half of the population lived below the poverty line in 2017<sup>8</sup>), and access to basic services. Water and sanitation and Adequate Housing have been defined as the basic needs to be analysed in French Guiana.

Is French Guiana part of the European Union?

French Guiana, as part of France, forms part of the European Union- the largest landmass for an area outside of Europe (since Greenland left the European Community in 1985), with one of the longest EU external boundaries.

How many deputies does French Guiana have?

French Guiana sends two deputies to the French National Assembly, one representing the commune (municipality) of Cayenne and the commune of Macouria, and the other representing the rest of French Guiana. This latter constituency is the largest in the French Republic by land area.

In addition, the most significant part of social housing in French Guiana is located in Cayenne (34%)<sup>79</sup>, with 44% of dwellings less than 20 years old and 71% less than 30 years old<sup>80</sup>.
