

Are renewables cost-competitive in Greenland?

Generally, high fuel prices allow for greater solar installations and thus fuel savings under an economic minimization model. The low costs of fuels in Greenland make it challenging for renewables to become cost-competitive in the analysis.

Does Greenland have a diesel price?

Therefore the consumer diesel price in Qaanaaq is the same as in the much farther south Nuuk. The only tax imposed on fuel is a small environmental tax, unlike Denmark and other European countries that apply energy, CO₂, NO_x, and value added taxes. The consumer price of fuel in Greenland is therefore very low compared to Europe.

How are fuel costs determined in Greenland?

Fuel costs in Greenland are determined by an agreement between a fuel wholesaler, PolarOil, and the Government. Fuel is bought in bulk on a yearly basis and stored in local deposits to ensure price stability. The fuel price is fixed for all localities to ensure equity.

What is Greenland's domestic energy demand?

All scenarios include Greenland's domestic energy demand. The list of scenarios is as follows: "Steady Europe": In 2030, 1.65% of European demand for liquid hydrocarbons is included, in addition to 5% of European demand for e-ammonia and e-methanol. In 2050, 10% of the demand for e-FTL, e-ammonia, and e-methanol is supplied.

Can Greenland export renewable electricity?

A connection between Greenland and Europe through a sub-sea cable to export renewable electricity has been previously considered [87, 88]. One project has been announced by H2Carrier and Anori to develop a 1.5 GW wind farm and a floating green ammonia production vessel off the shore of Greenland.

Is Greenland a good place for offshore wind power?

However, a study on wind and wave power potential on 22 islands has found Greenland to be one of the best sites for offshore wind power with 4555-5450 full load hours (FLH) in addition to good conditions for wave power with 1050-4000 FLH. Satymov et al. found 5000-6000 FLH in the south of Greenland for an improved wave energy converter.
