Guatemala City (Spanish: Ciudad de Guatemala), (also known nationally colloquially by the nickname as Guate), is the national capital and largest city of the Republic of Guatemala. The name "Guatemala" comes from the Nahuatl word Cuauhtemallan, or "place of many trees", a derivative of the K'iche' Mayan word for "many trees" [15 ][16 ] or, perhaps more specifically, for the Cuate/Cuatli tree Eysenhardtia.

What is Guatemala known for?

Guatemala City also dominates the cultural life of the country. It is the seat of the principal faculties of the San Carlos University of Guatemala (established 1676 in Antigua Guatemala); the major institutions for artistic, commercial, vocational, and military education; the Society of Geography and History; and several important museums.
