How powerful is Weibo compared to other social media platforms?

The above cases make clear that compared to other social media platforms, Weibo has a powerful ability, due to its large sample size, to study and track sentiment, affective states, online behaviours, and communications within the Chinese socio-cultural context.

Which governmental accounts on Weibo are the best?

In recent years, People's Daily regularly released Governance Index Weibo Impact Report about governmental accounts on Weibo in terms of their communication, services, interactivity and recognition. According to the latest report in 2019, @China Police Online, @Central Youth League and @China fire are the top three in the ranking list.

What is Weibo & how does it work?

Weibo is a microblogging application, launched by Sina Corporation in 2009, based on user relationships to share, disseminate and get information. As of Q4 2019, it has over 516 million monthly active users (compared to Twitter's 300 million), making it only the second largest social media platform in China after WeChat.

Can Weibo improve local governance in China?

While most studies of Chinese social media focus on censorship, Weibo is helping to improve local governance in China. Most foreign studies on Chinese microblogs probe patterns of censorship, paying scant attention to how state-society conflicts are neutralized by local governments or how changes are introduced into local governance itself.

How many Weibo accounts are there?

According to Zhang & Guo (2019), Weibo had 33,000 verified mainstream media accounts, which collectively published 1.7 million posts by November 2017. Journalists described their Weibo accounts as 'online petition offices', which suggests citizens still look to the news media to voice their concerns on their behalf.

Will Weibo be archived for non-commercial use?

A sign of the social media platforms importance, in April 2019, the National Library of China announced that it will archive all public posts on Weibo for non-commercial uses.
