What should I do if my neighbours oppose solar panels?

The first step in addressing any objections is to talk to your neighboursand try to understand their concerns. Some common concerns that neighbours may have about solar panel installations include: Visual impact: Neighbours may be concerned that the solar panels will be unsightly and reduce the aesthetic appeal of the neighbourhood.

Can neighbours object to solar panels?

Neighbours have the right to object solar panel installations if they believe the installation does not comply with the relevant regulations. The objections are typically submitted to the local planning authority, which reviews the concerns and ensures that the installation adheres to the permitted development rules.

Why do neighbours oppose solar panels?

The location and size of solar panels are two key factors that can lead to objections from neighbours. Solar panels should be sited to minimise their visual impact on the local area and not exceed certain size limitations. For example, solar panels should not protrude more than 200mm (about 7.87 inches) from the roof's surface.

Do neighbours complain about solar PV and wind power?

As long as solar PV and wind power have been around, there have been neighbours who complain about them. Whether it spoils their views or makes too much noise, there is always someone ready to complain.

Can solar panels be installed in a conservation area?

To increase the chances of your solar panel installation being approved in a conservation area, you can make a few upfront choices, such as: Selecting solar panel styles that blend in with your roof or building's design, such as solar tiles. Black solar panels tend to look much more appealing than blue

Are solar panels bad for Your Neighbourhood?
