Why is electricity so expensive in Saint Lucia?

Over 55 percent of firms identify the high cost of electricity as a major constraint to doing business in Saint Lucia. While electricity is supplied reliably, the country remains almost completely dependent on expensive imported fuels for diesel-based generation.

How many microgrids are there in Saint Lucia?
