

Where is Central African Republic launching a new solar park?

BANGUI, November 17, 2023 - Today, the Central African Republic is launching a new 25-megawatt solar park with battery storage in Danzi village, located around 18 kilometers from Bangui. The park will supply electricity to 250,000 persons in the capital, almost doubling the country's electricity generation capacity.

Will Central African Republic have electricity by 2030?

By 2030, almost half of the population of the Central African Republic should have access to electricity, compared to only 16% at present. Today, the Central African Republic is launching a new 25-megawatt solar park with battery storage in Danzi village, located around 18 kilometers from Bangui.

Why is Central African Republic investing in electricity?

With an electrification rate of 35% in Bangui, 8% in the main provincial cities and towns, and only 2% in rural communes, the Central African Republic has invested in the energy sector as an engine of development to increase access to electricity and promote sustainable growth.

What is the Bess consortium?

The BESS Consortium is a multi-stakeholder partnership set up to ensure these BESS benefits transform energy systems across low- and middle-income countries (LMICs). The Consortium is on track to meet its target of securing 5 GW of BESS commitments by the end of 2024 and deploying these by the end of 2027.

A big one is that the combined installation of solar PV and BESS may not supply electricity between 9 am and 5 pm from May to September, instead reserving those hours to charge the BESS with solar for discharging to the grid between 5 pm and 9 am. The BESS can also participate in other electricity market avenues during those off-peak hours.

Other ongoing solar and BESS projects. There are several other projects currently at different stages of the planning process, which serve as examples of how these ventures can play out. A proposal at a similar stage is the Springwell Solar Farm in North Kesteven, Lincolnshire, which announced its consultation on 11 December 2023.

The project consists of a 360MWp agriPV solar farm and the 40MW/82.5MWh BESS "Palmadula" facility, which Enerside has sold to Chint Solar, a developer and independent power producer (IPP).
