

Why is South Sudan facing a serious energy crisis?

South Sudan faces a serious energy crisis due to a number of factors, including devastating conflicts (e.g. 1955-1972, 1983-2005 & 2013-present) and reliance on the fossil fuel source. The country has the lowest energy consumption rate in Africa and the highest cost of producing energy (World Bank, 2016).

What is South Sudan's energy potential?

Despite being a young nation, South Sudan has an enormous and diverse energy potential, ranging from nonrenewable energy sources to renewable energy sources. It holds not only a huge amount of oil resources but also has considerable potential in solar energy, wind energy, hydropower, geothermal energy.

Why is energy infrastructure underdeveloped in South Sudan?

Partly due to the civil wars (e.g., 1955-1972, 1983-2005 & 2013-present), energy infrastructure remains very underdeveloped in South Sudan. Despite a peace agreement in 2015, which has been revitalized recently, conflict has impeded the country's effort in transitioning to renewable energy.

Where is South Sudan located?

The Republic of South Sudan is a land-locked country located in East-Central Africa with a population of 11.4 million people. In 2020, the World Bank, in response to South Sudan's transitional government's request, set up the Pathways to Electricity Access Expansion in South Sudan ASA (Advisory Services and Analytics).
