

Where can I buy solar panels in South Sudan?

Their largest market is the Central Equatoria state. Founded in 2011 and opened its first branch in Asmara, Eritrea. Branches located in South Sudan, Uganda, and Dubai. In South Sudan, they have shops in Yei, Wau, Juba and Malakal. -Specialise in large solar home systems with a minimum capacity of 600W onwards.

Does South Sudan have a solar PV market?

The solar PV market in South Sudan is growing steadily, but minimal information is available. Additionally, most companies operating in the country within the value chain do not have an online presence. As such, the study mainly relied on primary information collected from the companies with which key informant interviews were conducted.

How long does solar energy last in South Sudan?

Proponents of solar energy argue that a solar system can produce reliable electricity for about 25 years. Having recognised solar energy potential, South Sudan is expected to put more emphasis on development of solar energy sector as part of its fight against energy poverty and economic diversification.

How solar energy can transform South Sudan's economy?

A solar energy can also be transformative to South Sudan's economy. For example, solar energy is affordable, cleaner and last longer as compared to energy from diesel-powered generators because generators need diesel to burn and they also need to be replaced after few years.

What percentage of solar lighting products are sold in South Sudan?

Over 85% of these sales have been quality-verified products primarily sold to the humanitarian sector. For the general market, an estimated 80-90% of solar lighting products are sold in Juba (Altai Consulting, 2014). Data on micro and mini-grid development in South Sudan is scarce.

How do solar companies work in South Sudan?

Of-grid solar companies in South Sudan focus on serving large institutions and commercial customers, who make up over 80% of their sales. They prefer serving international NGOs and aid organisations operating in the country since these organisations can readily pay, unlike households. This leaves the household market underserved.
