What is the air quality like in Saint Vincent & the Grenadines?

The air quality is generally acceptable for most individuals. However, sensitive groups may experience minor to moderate symptoms from long-term exposure. Which month is most humid in St Vincent & the Grenadines?

The least humid month in St Vincent and the Grenadines is February (60.1% relative humidity). The most humid month is November (69.3%). Wind in St Vincent and the Grenadines is usually moderate. Februaryis the windiest month, followed by January and March. The average wind speed of around 13 knots (14.9 MPH or 24.1 KPH) in February is considered "a moderate breeze."

Where does the sun shine in Saint Vincent & the Grenadines?

However, the sun shines more often on the coast. Saint Vincent and the Grenadines is an archipelago, made up of no less than 125 islands, most of which are very small. The main islands of the Grenadines are Bequia, Mustique, Canouan, Mayreau, Union Island, Palm Island, and Petit Saint Vincent.

What is the average wind speed in St Vincent & the Grenadines?

The average top sustained winds in St Vincent and the Grenadines reach 16.8 knots, or a moderate breeze, on average in late February and early March.

How often does Saint Vincent and the Grenadines get rainy?

In Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, temperatures vary by 20C throughout the year. Rainfall, particularly during the rainy season between June and October, occurs less frequently as the historical record progresses with temperatures above the 99th percentile, R99. Mean temperatures peak during this period.

How to travel in Saint Vincent & the Grenadines?

Traffic flows on the left side of the road in Saint Vincent and the Grenadines. Always pay close attention to the flow of traffic, especially when crossing the street. The average hourly wind speed in Saint Vincent and the Grenadines is rapidly decreasing during the summer, decreasing from 16.7 miles per hour to 13.4 miles per hour over the course of the season. For reference, on February 8, the windiest day of the year, the daily average wind speed is 17.5 miles per hour, while on September 13, the ...

Wind direction is East, wind speed varies between 4.5 and 8.9 mph with gusts up to 8.9 mph. The sky is clear with a chance of rain 0%. Wind and wave weather forecast for Saint-Vincent, Saint Vincent and the

The best time to visit St Vincent and the Grenadines is from December to April, when the nights are cooler and the days hot. The rainy season is from June, with rainfull heavy in the mountains and short, sharp bursts on the coast.

Is it windy in St. Vincent and the Grenadines? St. Vincent and the Grenadines is a destination with rather light or moderate winds. The wind blows the most in April - July and the least in August - November.

The most windy month in St Vincent is January when the average maximum windspeed is 30KM/H (18MPH) and the average wind speed is 23KM/H (14MPH). The least windy month in St Vincent is September when the average maximum windspeed is 21KM/H (13MPH) and the average wind speed is 15KM/H (9MPH) .



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
