

Is there a market for roof-top solar energy systems in Timor-Leste?

Australia's Market Development Facility (MDF) and ITP Renewables conducted an assessment of the potential market for roof-top solar energy systems in Timor-Leste.

Will CNNP move into the solar market of Timor-Leste?

The renewables unit of China National Nuclear Power (CNNP) is considering a move into the solar market of the Southeast Asian market of Timor-Leste, two sources told Infralogic. CNNP Rich Energy is interested in taking part in an international tender to develop a solar plus battery energy storage system, they said.

How long does a solar system last in Timor-Leste?

High electricity costs and readily available solar radiation mean that the average payback period for a rooftop photovoltaic (PV) solar energy system in Timor-Leste is only 1.5 to 3 years instead of the global average of 6-10 years. Transitioning to solar can also help the country meet environmental commitments.

Is Timor-Leste a good country for solar energy?

Timor-Leste has a high-quality solar resource. The global horizontal irradiance in Dili is higher than on the east coast of Australia, where the solar market is mature and installation costs are higher. The cost of electricity in Timor-Leste for commercial and industrial consumers is high compared to ASEAN countries.

Does Timor-Leste have a solar system?

"Timor-Leste" has another solar system that was introduced in the past project, and has allocated the budget to the renewal of batteries of the system. Little maintenance cost is required for the grid connected system.

Can a Timor-Leste solar power plant be financed?

The tender, which was announced in February this year by state utility Eletricidade de Timor-Leste, is seeking an investor that can design, finance, operate and maintain a 72-85 MW solar power plant and a 36-43 MW battery energy project under long-term purchase agreements with the state grid in the capital city of Manatuto, the sources said.

TagEnergy's largest capacity battery storage facility in the UK - a 49.5MW/99MWh site near Luton - has gone live. Located at Chapel Farm the £30 million development is a joint venture with Harmony Energy, following TagEnergy acquiring a 60% stake in the project in November 2021.
