Before the solar farm, Tonga relied entirely on diesel fuel to generate electricity - which is both costly, and harmful to the environment. Now, solar helps provide around 4% of the country's total electricity demand.

The Maama Mai solar facility was commissioned in July 2012 by his Majesty King Tupou VI at Tonga Power Limited's Power Station at Popua. The project was funded by the NZ Aid Programme at a total of \$7.9 million NZD.

It will provide 100% electricity accessibility to over 280 households on the island. The system is a hybrid of solar and thermal power, which will ensure a reliable and efficient supply of electricity, even during inclement weather. The OIREP project is the longest standing energy project in Tonga.
