Wednesday it had recently inaugurated its two solar farms with a combined capacity of 21.07 MWp in El Salvador.

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The Salvadoran Government, under President Nayib Bukele, is advancing the construction of Talnique Solar, the country's first state-owned solar power plant. Anticipated to start operations by the end of 2023, it will supply renewable energy to roughly 25,000 households.

Statistics from Olade indicate a notable 12% increase in renewable energy generation in 2023, constituting 65% of the total electric generation in Latin America. Solar power led the charge with a remarkable 46% growth, closely followed by a 10% increase in wind energy.

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
